Payment and Facilitation Instructions

This is a 1 hour, locally facilitated (NOT online) course, aimed at providing your "teen helpers" (aged 12-17 years) with a basic induction into the core concepts of Safe Ministry. It includes downloadable videos, a facilitator's guide, participants handouts, and a certificate template.



As the Children/Youth Ministry Leader, it will be your task to facilitate this course for your teen helpers in an in-person group environment.

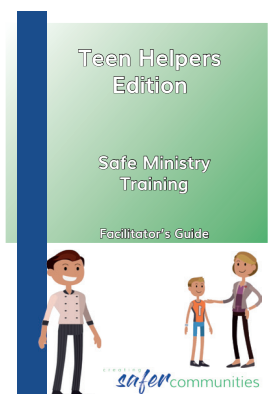
- Click on the link you receive via email. This will open the training platform in your internet browser.
